



Maurina Family Memorial Scholarship Criteria

This scholarship will be awarded annually, beginning with the Norway-Vulcan graduating class of 1999. All applicants must complete the scholarship application form by the announced deadline and the recipient will be selected by the local scholarship committee.

1. The scholarship is named for the Maurina Family, who believed strongly in affording Norway-Vulcan students the opportunity to pursue their educational career goals.
2. The scholarship is a yearly one time award and can not be renewed.
3. Applications must be on file in the counselor's office by **March 15th**. Failure to turn in your application by the due date will result in being ineligible to apply for this scholarship.
4. The annual scholarship award will be based on the amount of annual interest earned on the invested principal.
5. The recipient must be a current graduate who plans to attend an institution of higher learning to pursue a degree in either the field of pharmacy or elementary education.
6. Financial need **WILL** be a factor in the selection process.
7. Scholarship requirements will include; character, dedication, personality, and a genuine interest in pursuing a post secondary degree in either pharmacy or elementary education.
8. Essay (200 words) must be submitted on why you chose this field of education and how your character and personality will be a benefit to this area of study.
9. The scholarship committee will consist of the following:

 - High School Principal
 - Elementary Principal
 - High School Guidance Counselor
